

## Curriculum Reform Survey

Gathering student feedback about curriculum reform regarding reproductive rights and family planning care.

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Reflection on a case: You are a family practitioner and report to your patient that she is 5 weeks pregnant. She asks about her options including abortion, she does not state her reasons: Which of the following options are you willing to do for a female patient who has decided to discontinue a pregnancy? *Choose ALL that apply.*
